Overview

The NEBOSH National General Certificate is a recognised qualification designed to help those with health and safety responsibilities for example managers supervisors and employee representatives to carry out their duties at work more effectively and to protect the organisations for which they work. It will help ensure that decisions are made from a position of knowledge across a broad range of hazards and work activities

Target Audience

It is the most widely held health and safety qualification in the UK with over 160,000 people having gained the award since it was launched in 1989. No previous health and safety knowledge is required but students must be able to write short reports. The duration of study for the National General Certificate is a minimum of 87 hours plus private study and background reading. Each written paper consists of one long-answer question and ten short-answer questions. All questions are compulsory.

Assessment Process

Each written paper consists of one long-answer question and ten short-answer questions. All questions are compulsory. The syllabus is divided into three units - Two taught units NGC1 and GC2 which contain the following elements and an unsupervised practical assessment Unit GC3.

Syllabus

Unit NGC1: Management of Health and Safety:

- Health and safety Foundations
- Health and safety Policy
- Organising for health and safety - culture
- Planning for health and safety - risk assessment/control
- Measuring, audit and review
- Incident and accident investigation recording and reporting

Unit GC2: Controlling Workplace Hazards:

- Workplace hazards and risk control
- Transport hazards and risk control
- Musculoskeletal hazards and risk control
- Work equipment hazards and risk control
- Electrical safety

- Fire Safety
- Chemical and biological health hazards and risk control
- Physical and psychological health hazards and risk control

Unit GC3: Health and safety practical application:

- Demonstrate the ability to apply knowledge of the unit NGC1 and GC2 syllabus by successful completion of a health and safety inspection of a workplace
- Complete a report to management regarding the inspection with recommendations

*To be submitted within two weeks following final exam.
